

BA Mission and Ministry Certificate – Level 4

Units and content

Study skills (10 credits)

This unit provides students with the necessary tools for studying effectively at HE Levels 4-6.

Applied practice (20 credits)

This unit focuses on the practice of mission and ministry through observation, reflection and action in context. Students will be taught reflective skills and encouraged to use them in starting to analyse their own practice and that of others, in order to better understand why what works well and why, and how to improve what doesn't.

Introduction to theology and youth/children/families (20 credits)

This unit introduces key doctrines and theological frameworks of the Christian faith. It will equip students to engage with the theological aspect of reflection within youth, children and families' mission and ministry.

Introduction to mission to and with youth/children/families (20 credits)

This unit introduces biblical, historical and contemporary concepts of mission, and relates it to practice amongst youth, children and families.

Issues facing young people/children/families (20 credits)

This unit introduces students to the key issues facing youth, children and families in 21st-century Britain.

Spirituality and faith (20 credits)

This unit introduces key theories relating to spirituality and faith development in contemporary Britain.

Leadership, team and self (10 credits)

This unit introduces students to leadership and team-building skills and the ability to manage oneself professionally.
